Attention to Graduate Students

- 1. Please check that you registered to 2021-2022 Spring Semester and get approval of your advisor through METU SIS.
- 2. Any change completed during the add-drop period regarding the registered courses should also be approved by your advisor through METU SIS. Any change without approval on METU SIS by your advisor will not be effective.
- 3. All MSc and PhD students should complete all credited and non-credited courses (except courses with 500, 600, 800 and 900 codes, you should register to those courses until graduation) within the first four semesters. Please check your semester no and whether you have any missing course according to the curriculum.
- 4. Replacement of a course with another, if needed, should be carried out during the registrations through METU SIS.
- 5. For graduation, you should complete all must and elective courses of your curriculum. It is not possible to be exempt from a must-course or to take another course instead of a must-course.
- 6. After you have completed your first four semesters (course period), you are allowed to take course(s) only in the status of NI in the following semesters.
- 7. If you are a MSc student, you should register thesis courses with a code number of 500 and 800, if you are a PhD student, you should register thesis courses with a code number of 600 and 900. Please be sure that you registered to the correct course and section number.
- 8. Please notice to the course categories. Must and elective courses based on the curriculum of your department should be registered in the correct course category. Courses taken with incorrect category may cause serious problems when you are about to graduate. Remember that course category cannot be changed after the letter grades are given.
- 9. You should take a research-methods and ethics course during your graduate education. Please be sure that you take required number of seminar courses according to the curriculum of your department.
- 10. All course load should be successfully completed to take PhD qualifying exams.
- 11. PhD students, who are conditionally successful in the qualifying exams, should take the course(s) stated by the department's doctoral committee in the status of NI.
